Paper Logbooks Are Out, Electronic Logbooks Are In, and It's All About the DRIVER

This is Jim.



Jim has been a truck driver for over 15 years. With the U.S. and now Canada mandating Electronic Logging Devices (ELD), Jim now needs to electronically track his Hours of Service (H.O.S).

#1

Using His Smartphone,



Jim connects to the Electronic Logging Device (ELD) through Bluetooth connectivity. He hops in his truck, double checks that his phone is connected, then logs into the Driver App and begins driving.

Note: A notification may arise for Jim to complete his Driver Vehicle Inspection Report (DVIR) if he leaves his vehicle for some time. This is easily done on the Driver App

To Do So,



Jim needs AirIQ's Electronic Logging Device (ELD). He needs to contact AirIQ to order his device.

#3

When The Device Arrives



Jim has to plug in his AirIQ Electronic Logging Device (ELD) into the Electronic Control Module (ECM) of his vehicle.

Then Jim Needs To...



Download the Hours of Service (H.O.S) Driver App on either his smartphone or tablet from either the Google Play Store or the App Store and set up his individual Driver credentials.

Which includes a ruggedized tablet that sits in the vehicle and automatically connects when in the cradle. With this option, Jim does not need to have his smartphone with him. Today, all Jim needs to do is hop in, log his credentials in and head off on his delivery.

- You are driving more than 8 days in a 30-day period.
 - You are driving a vehicle manufactured after the year 2000.
 - You are travelling more than 160 km a day
